### RULES FOR THE NEW LIFE

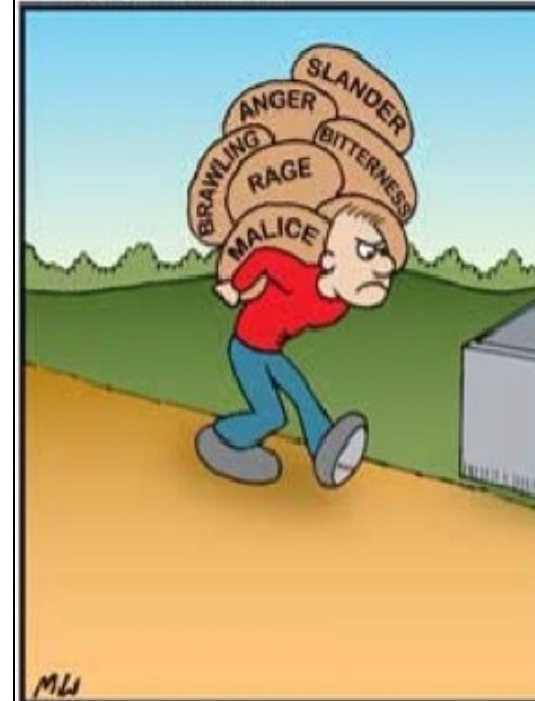

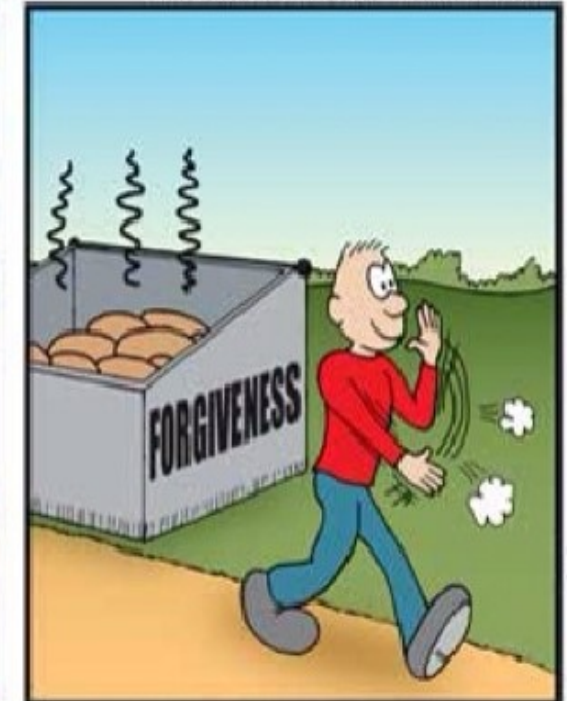
