#### WEEK-THREE SCRIPTURE—Isaiah 61:1-4, 8-11

61 The spirit of the Lord God is upon me because the Lord has anointed me; he has sent me to bring good news to the oppressed, to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and release to the prisoners, <sup>2</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, 3 to provide for those who mourn in Zion— to give them a garland instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of a faint spirit. They will be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, to display his glory. <sup>4</sup>They shall build up the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former devastations; they shall repair the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.

<sup>8</sup> For I, the LORD, love justice, I hate robbery and wrongdoing; I will faithfully give them their recompense, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. <sup>9</sup>Their descendants shall be known among the nations and their offspring among the peoples; all who see them shall acknowledge that they are a people whom the LORD has blessed. <sup>10</sup> I will greatly rejoice in the LORD; my whole being shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. <sup>11</sup> For as the earth brings forth its shoots and as a garden causes what is sown in it to spring up, so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring up before all the nations.

#### TRUSTEE UPDATE

The Trustees recently reviewed proposals on two interconnected projects and recommended the Church Council approve funding for both totaling \$49,007.87. It includes:

- campus-wide exterior and interior lighting upgrade,
- ceiling tile upgrade in the public areas, and
- replacement of damaged or stained tiles in the classrooms, admin offices and kitchen (health department requirement).

These are another major undertaking by our congregation to:

- reduce utility costs,
- add another layer of safety for after dark activities, and



• improve overall appearance.

The actual cost of this package is \$95,856.87; however, incentives from Potomac Edison and a Scott Foundation grant totaling \$46,849.00 results in our share noted above.
